SENPAI CORNER BY CHARLES

Spring is beginning...a little early this year, so definitely pay attention to the weather, in case we get a freeze. With the early bud swell, it is a good time to consider repotting any trees that need it. Any wiring done last year should be checked, and be aware that with the spring flush, your trees will be growing rapidly, so could quickly bite into any wiring. If you let things grow unhindered last year, now is a good time to thin out excess branches, and of course start adding wire. For major branch bending, I will be giving a demonstration this coming meeting on how to safely move a branch and reduce the risk of breaking. If you have not yet started, I would also encourage the start of your fertilizing regimen, using a low NPK balanced fertilizer. See you soon and let's plan for a great come back show in June.


ELECTIONS
