SENPAI CORNER BY CHARLES

Spring is just around the corner, and if you have not already started, you should be fertilizing your trees with a balanced fertilizer. Also, I would consider starting an anti-bug/fungus campaign... those little evil creatures have a place in the environment, just not on our trees. Consider an insecticidal soap, Neem oil, ladybugs, or depending on your views, you can go the nuclear option of chemicals. But, whatever your choice, be proactive, and not wait until you have a full infestation before tackling the problem. Another pesky thing to watch out for are the little weeds that will pop up, relishing the abundant water and fertilizer they are getting. The easiest solution is to remove them as soon as you see them.

And remember the gardeners rule to weeds: to determine if it is a weed or valuable plant, give it a gentle pull, if it comes out easy, it is a valuable plant.
