3 Weeks after changing the watering schedule, trimming the tree and now he sees mature growth! to quote Jack, "He thought he knew how to water his trees but he really only know how to water his dirt!"

LESSON FOR THE MONTH

Research the water required for each type of tree! Each variety has different requiremnts and it can affect the growth of your tree.
