NOVEMBER MEETING BY CHARLES

At our November meeting, we talked about wiring and the importance of good technique. Always anchor your wire and try to "spin" the wire onto your tree, this will help to keep the wire from becoming too tight. I also provided a photo of someone that had used different colored wire to wire out a branch. Reminder: when positioning your foliage on your pad try to fan out each clump.
